I am counsel for Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission. On December 19, 2011, the parties and the Court held a telephonic conference to discuss the possible resolution of this matter without further litigation. Based on that conference, the Court issued an Order requesting that the parties inform the Court of the status of the matter on or before March 1, 2012.

Both defendants have signed proposed consent agreements to the entry of final judgments. These agreements must be submitted to the Commission for approval – a necessary step before staff for the Commission can submit a proposed judgment to the Court. For this reason, the staff and defendants respectfully request the opportunity to report again to the Court within 45 days – at which time the Commission staff anticipates the approval process will be complete.
